MPLs provide fast and easy click-and-print capability. Simply choose a printer, click on it, and print! Select a list format, which shows printer names and includes a brief description of each, or choose map display, which indicates printer locations on a map of the facility.

Create an MPL and then add printers or import printers from HP Web Jetadmin and Novell print shares, saving you the time it would take to re-create the lists manually.

#### Create and modify user groups.


Establish user groups based on unique needs, such as color access, location, or online supplies ordering. Use HP's MPA software to associate user groups with available printers and to control printing features.



You can also install it in dynamic mode, which is unique to the HP Universal Print Driver. Dynamic mode allows users to find and connect to network print devices on their own—without IT or help desk assistance. Unlike product-specific drivers, users can print within any network or print environment without downloading a product-specific driver—perfect for on the road or for when users want to print to a new device.
